Thank you for your enquiry about our Support Worker posts. I have enclosed an application form and some information about our service and the job.

We have both full time and part time posts available, but you should be aware that the job will involve working shifts. These may include early mornings, evenings, sleep-ins, and weekends. Usually, staff work every other weekend. The reason for this is that many of the people we provide support to need support throughout the day.

The people we support live in their own homes or with their families, and so to get to work, you will need to be able to travel to the different places that they live. It is not absolutely necessary to have a car, however.

Our staff enjoy their jobs and feel they are doing something really worthwhile. It is varied work, and at times will involve doing interesting things with the person you are supporting. Many of the people we support have complex needs, and some have challenging behaviour, and so you should be the sort of person who is able to take things in your stride.
